<p>Sally Walker Distinguished Service Award</p>	<p>Evidence of <b>contributions to the field of gifted education</b> over time:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Advocacy contribution resulting in change of policy</li> <li>• Legislative contribution resulting in increased funding, mandates, teacher certification, or endorsement</li> <li>• Served in an advisory capacity at the state or national level with demonstrated results</li> </ul>	<p>Evidence of <b>long-term service and continued contributions to IAGC</b> over time:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• History of leadership roles (i.e., committees, officer positions)</li> <li>• Created and coordinated events or initiatives to improve or expand IAGC services</li> <li>• Participate in IAGC Conference as speaker, volunteer, regular attendee</li> </ul>	<p>Evidence of long-term <b>service to the field:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Career-long involvement in gifted education</li> <li>• Ongoing contribution to the field through journal articles, administration of a school for the gifted, or leadership positions</li> <li>• Expertise in a particular area such as program development which benefits the field</li> </ul>	<p>The nominee must have <b>ten or more years of active service</b> in the field of gifted education and show evidence of making major contributions with <b>lasting impact</b> on the field of gifted education.</p> <p>An individual may receive this award only once.</p>
